DATES TO REMEMBER

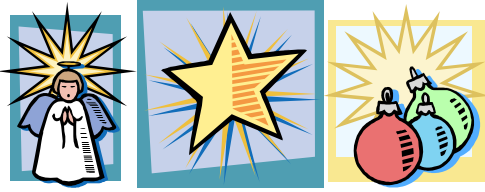
